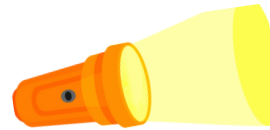
Try these fun activities with your Just Right Reader decodables. When you complete an activity, share a picture with your teacher! Can you get four in a row?

Read one of your Just Right Reader books to a friend.



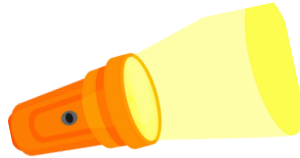
Pick a book with red on the cover. Read while in the car, on the bus, in a taxi, or while waiting at school.

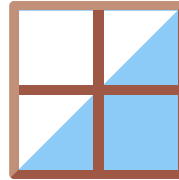

Read a book to a grown up.



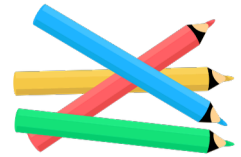
Look around your house. Find three or more things that start with your focus letter.

Write your focus letter. Draw a picture of something that starts with that letter.



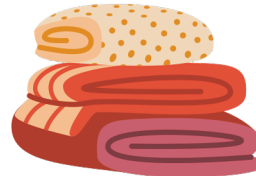
Read one of your Just Right Reader books in the afternoon.
