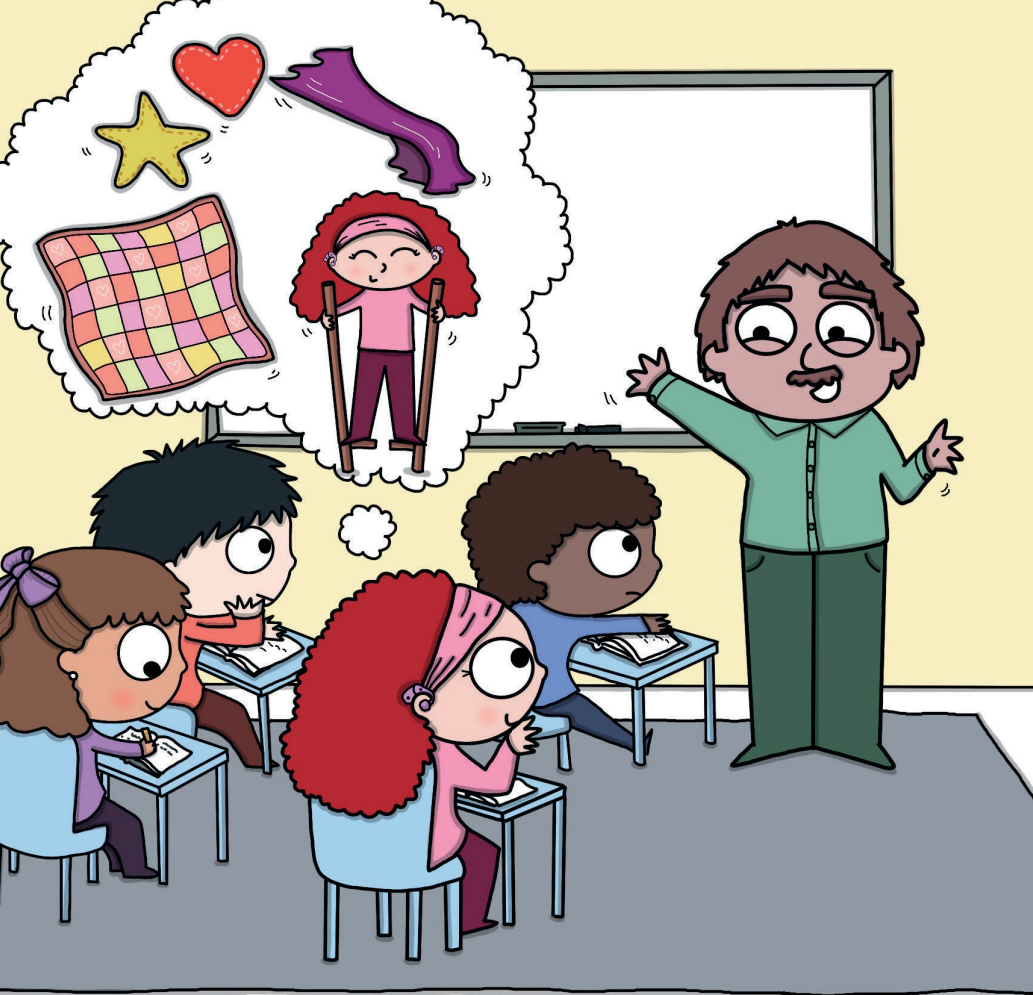
# My Elk Project

Chalk or salt?

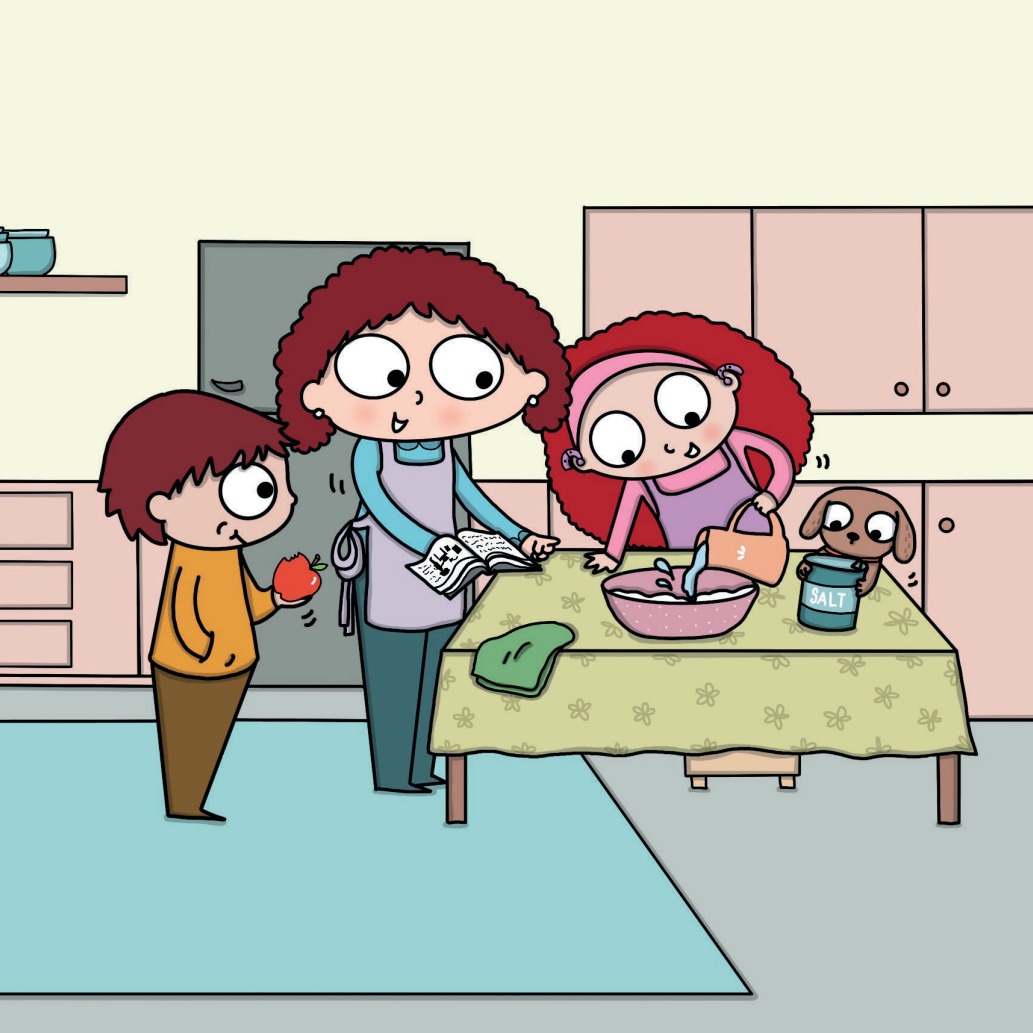
Chalk AND salt!

water.

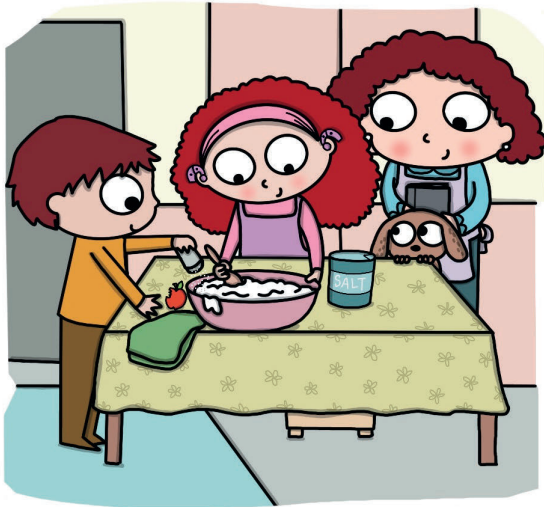
I tilt the water just a bit. Too
