



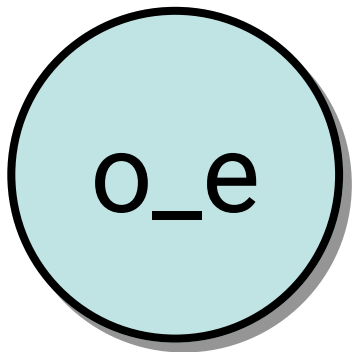

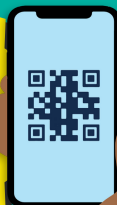
New Vocabulary
