



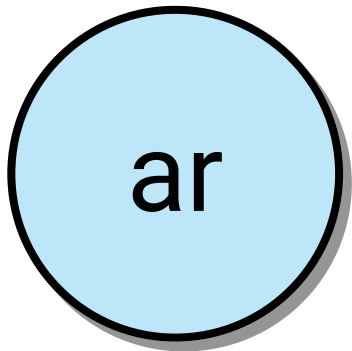

It wants to trade cards!

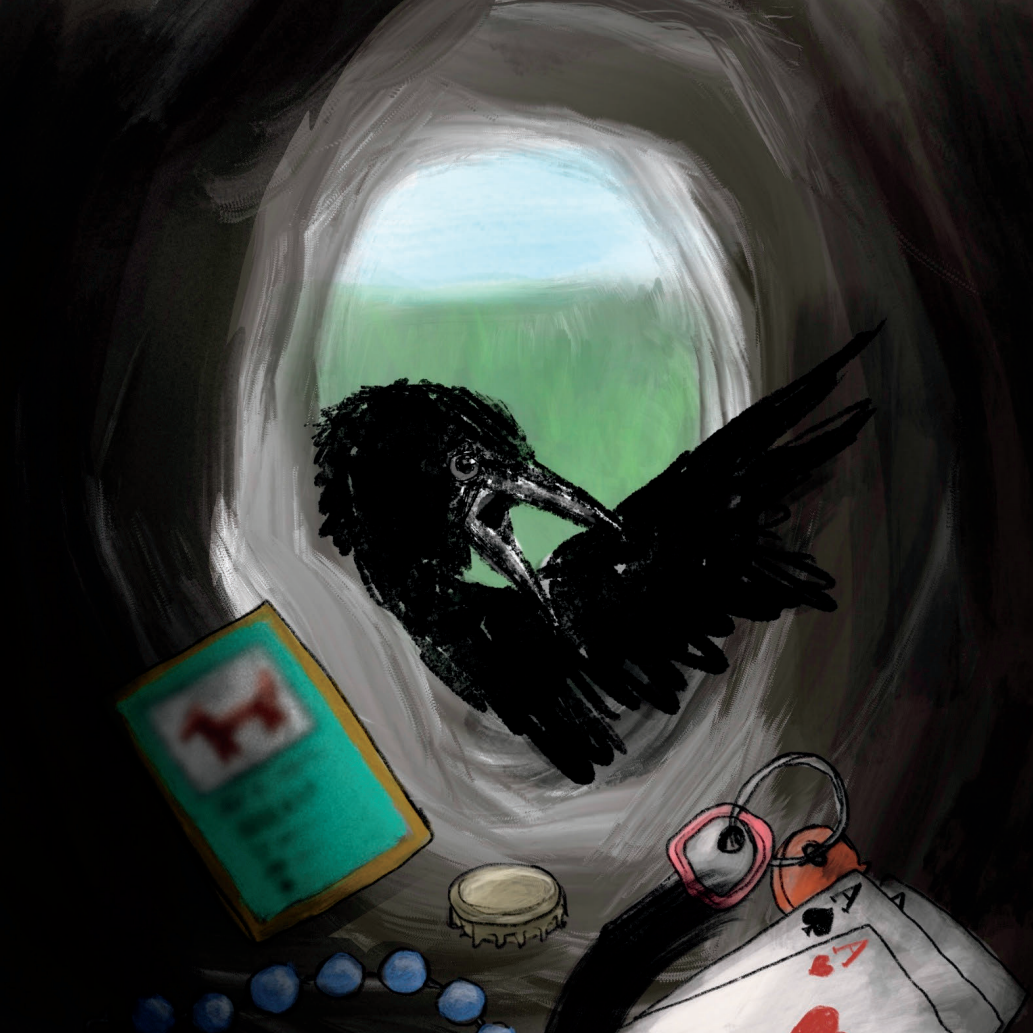
Clark takes the card and yells to
