But she couldn't believe her eyes.


A wolf stood on the field. Dressed in the same costume Lenny always wore.

BUZZ! The game was over. The Wolves had won! The crowd streamed down onto the field. They were filled with excitement. It was the Wolves' biggest win in a long time.






Olivia ran right over to the wolf mascot. Dante was just steps behind her.


