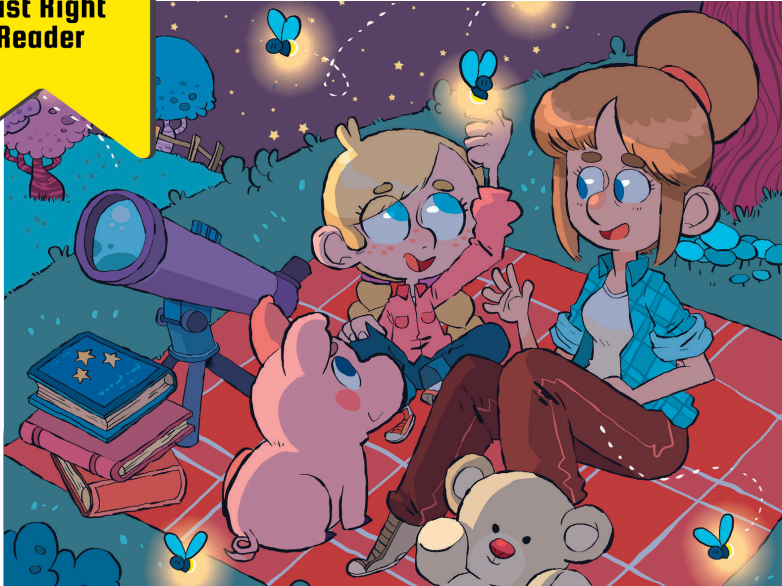

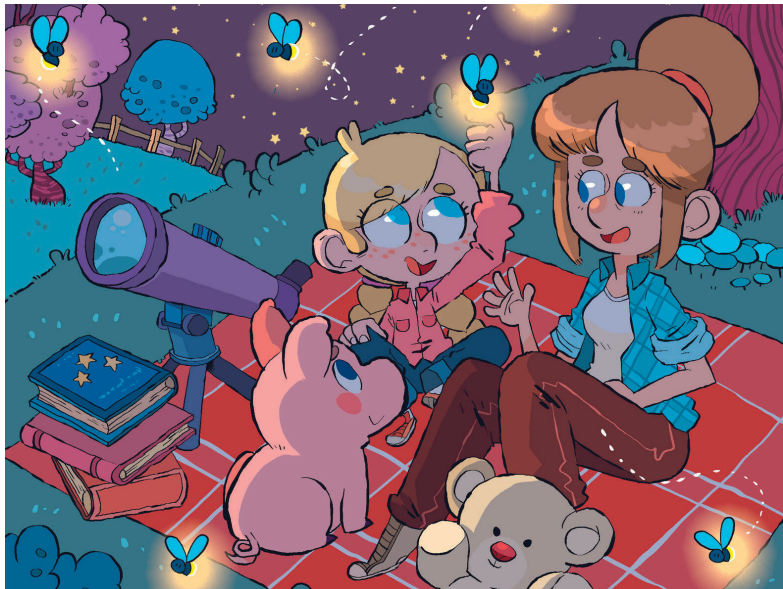

The cold chills right to your bones.

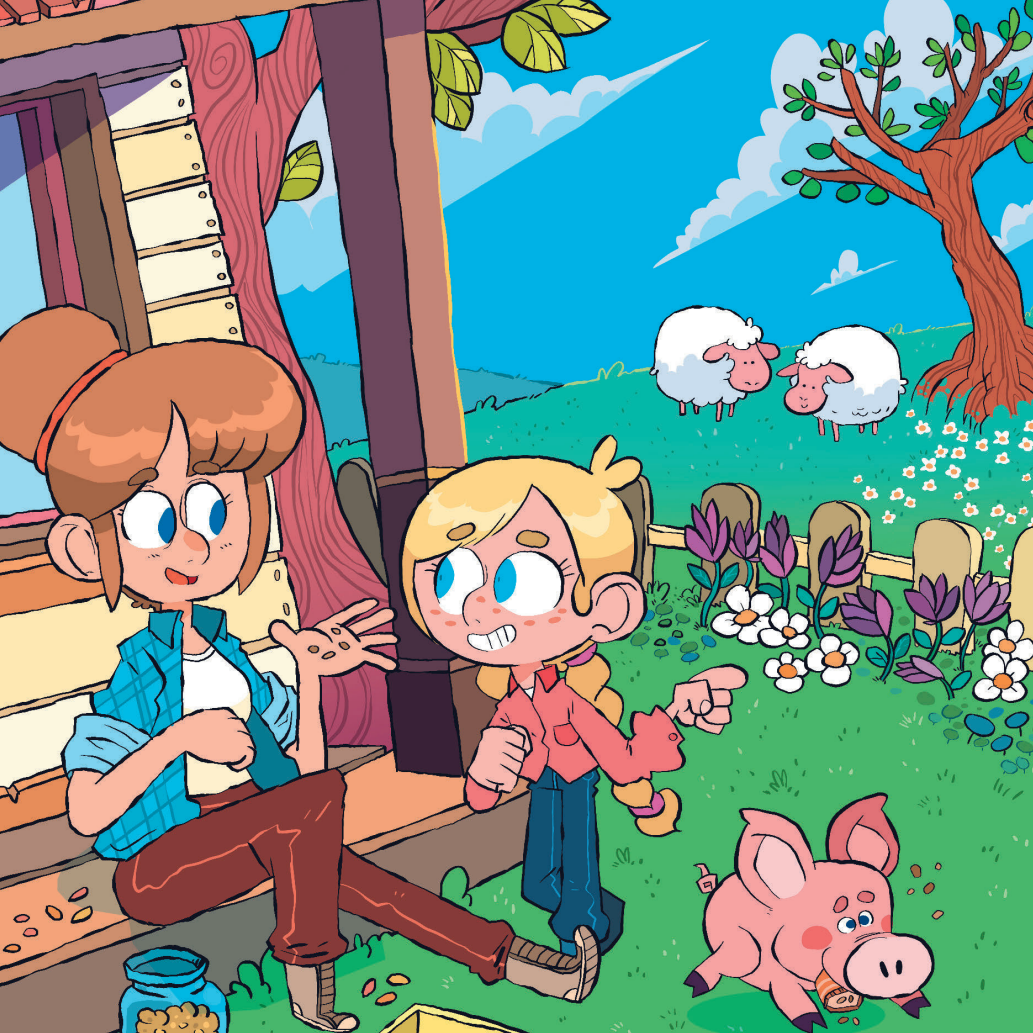


"It's spring," Lilly cries with delight.
