Wrenley has a wonderful writing teacher. Her name is Miss Knight.

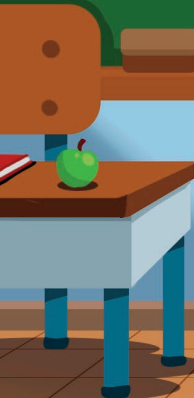
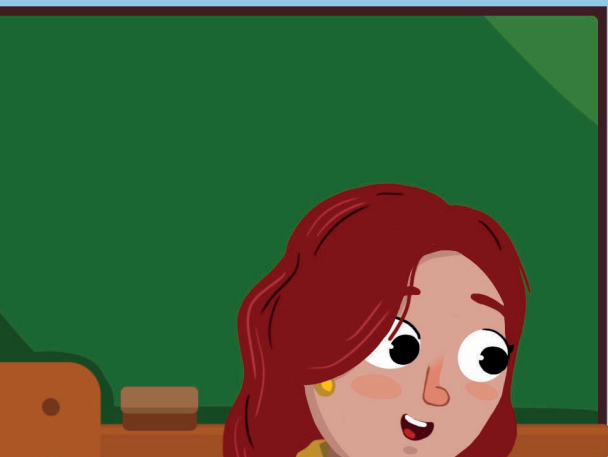
Miss Knight says, "First, think about what you know. Then you can write about what you know."
