

"Let's act fast," said Max.




"We've a long trek west," said Mom. "Or we can construct a raft."

If it's too fast, we can adjust and adapt."




"This raft will be so swift! We can't fall off!" Max said.

"I have our kit, Max."




The raft went fast on the swift river. It went past objects. It swept Mom and Max past the spot where they wanted to land.
