Josh is in shock.



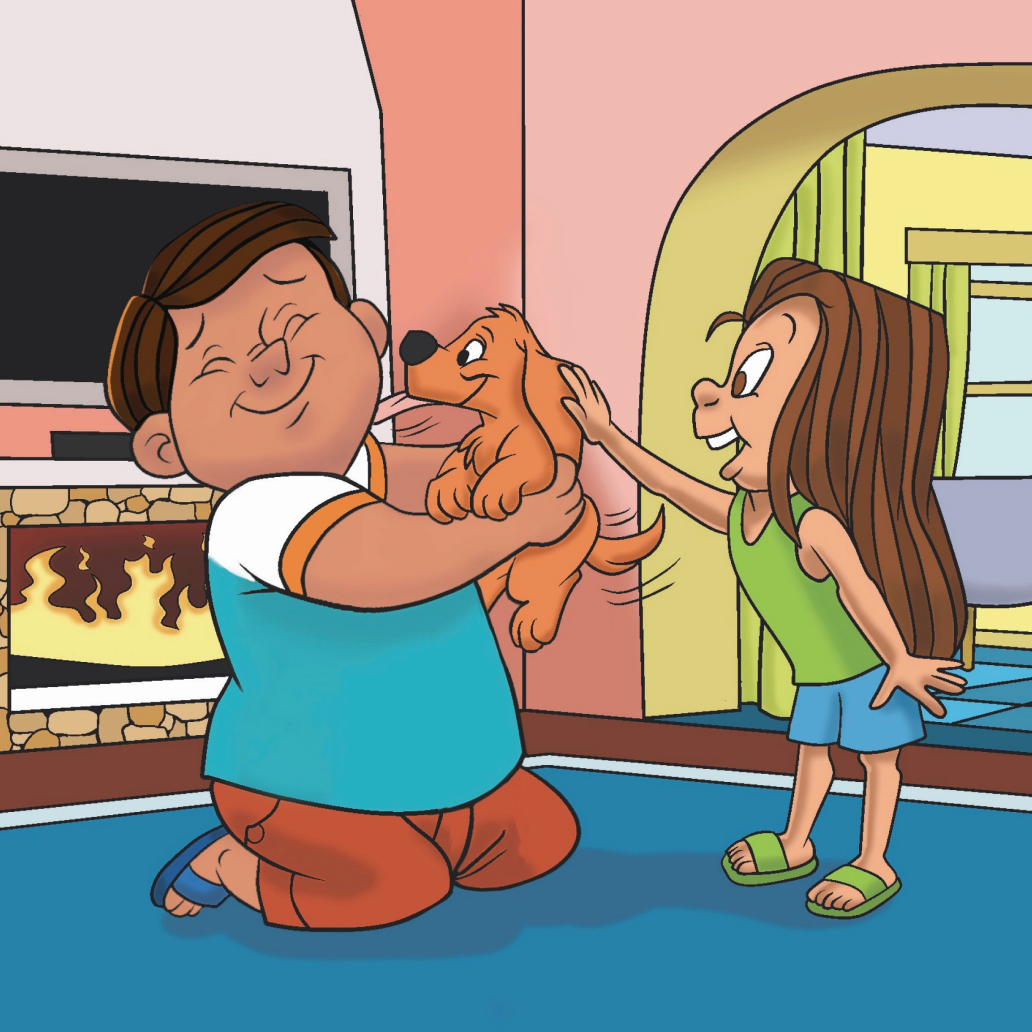
"What will you name your pup?"
