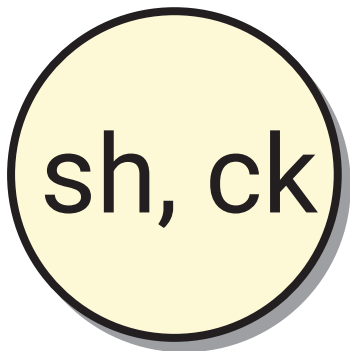

Sasha sits on the bed.

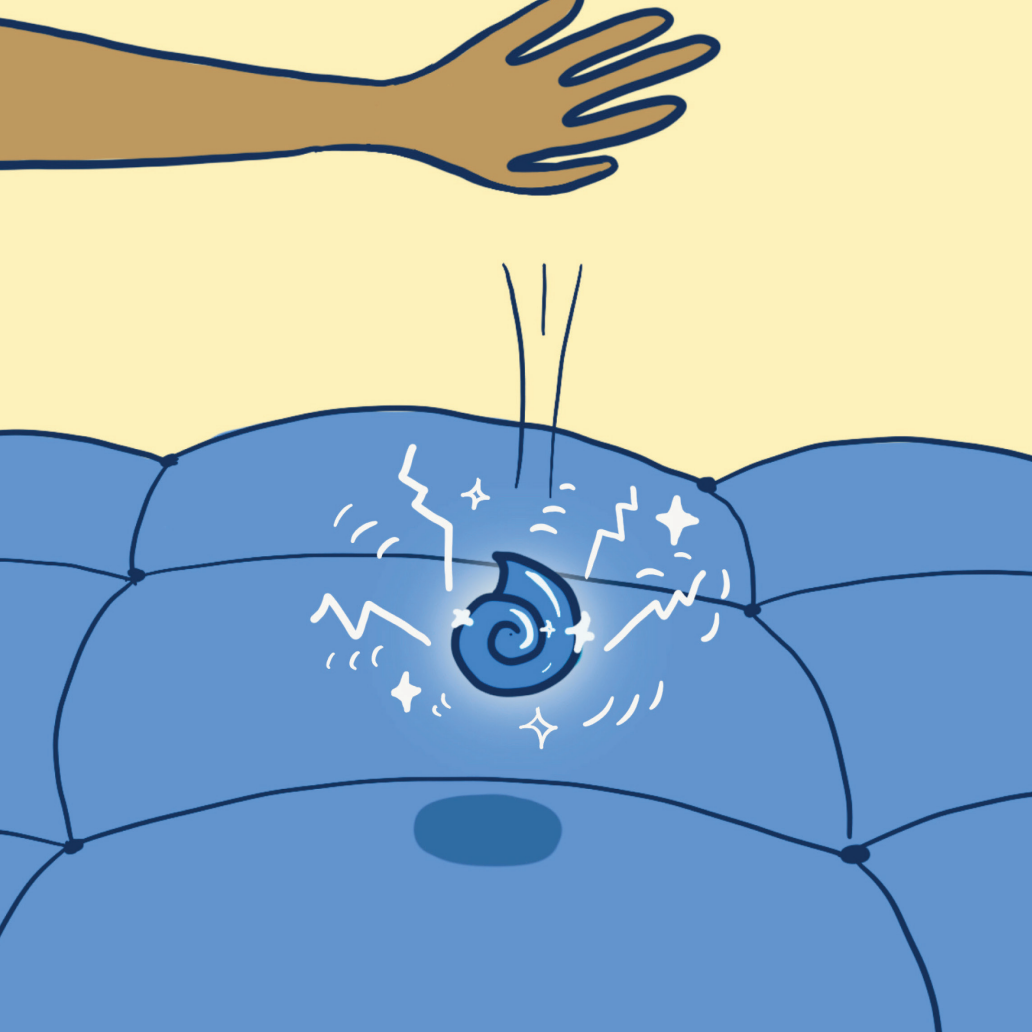
"OK, I will say a wish.

luck!"

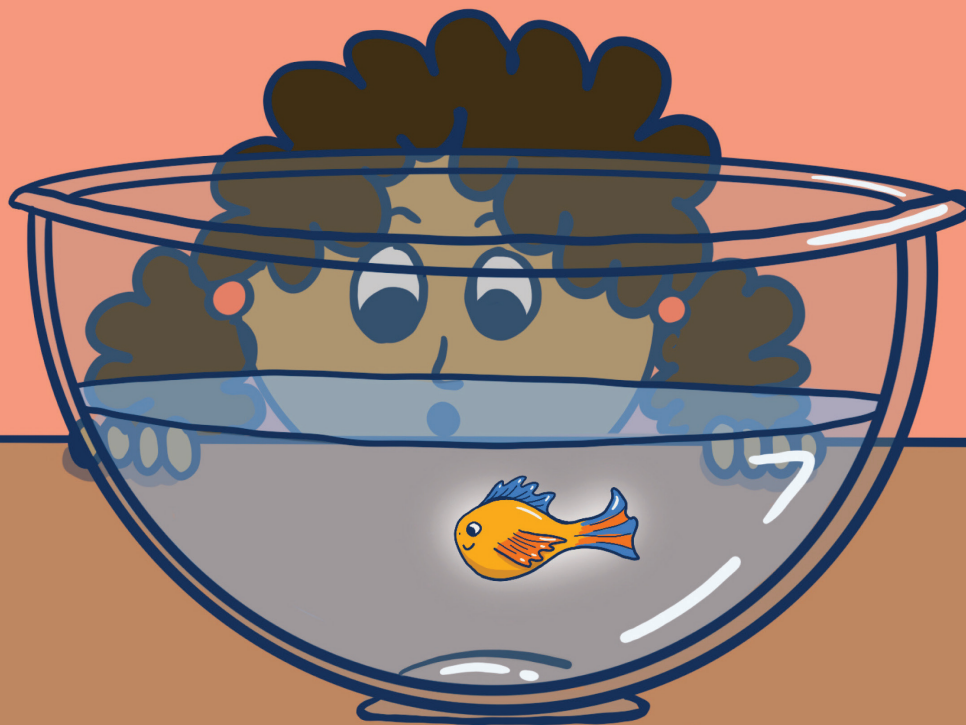
Sasha sets the shell in
