Spot is glad to go with Stef. She likes to stop and sniff. She likes sniffing for other pups.



Stef and Spot stop for a bit. Stef sees Cass.

Cass yells, "Is that your pup? What is her name?"

"Yes," says Stef. "Her name is Spot."

Cass claps and Spot goes to her.

Spot smells and licks her leg. Cass rubs her chin.



Spot likes Cass. Cass says to Stef, "Can I hang here and play with Spot too?"

"Yes!" says Stef.

"Spot likes to run and get this stick," adds Stef.

Cass tosses the stick. It is a long toss. Spot runs and comes back with the stick.



Stef gets the stick from Spot. Spot hops up and down.

Stef steps back and flings it over the path. Spot runs over and skids to a stop. She snaps it up.

"She got it!" claps Cass.



Cass and Stef plop down and pet Spot.

"I want a snack," says Cass. "Can Spot come with me to get a snack?"

Spot kisses Cass.

"She says YES!" yells Stef.



Stef, Spot, and Cass go to get a snack. Stef is glad Cass is with them. Spot is glad too.
