that are blue.**



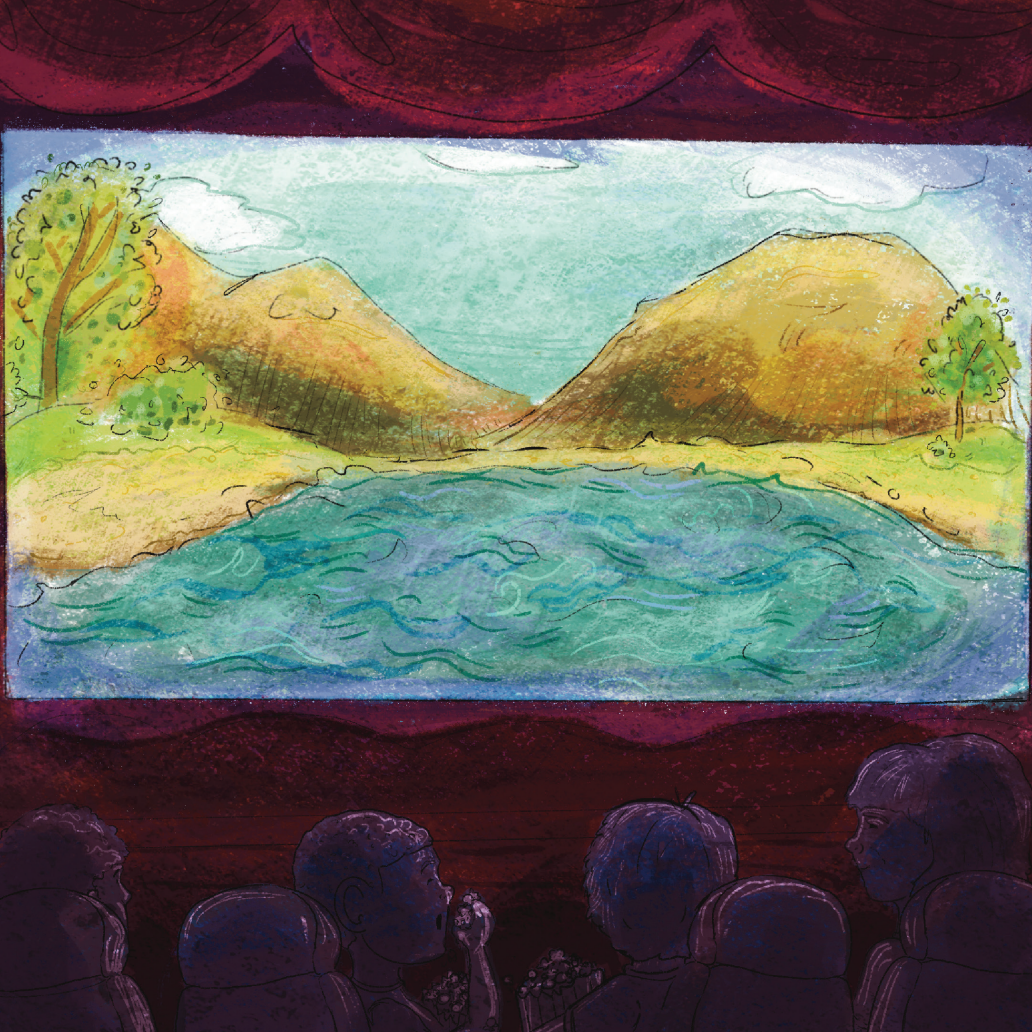
Next came clips of new movies.
