



"Was that a moose? Or a baboon? No, moose don't have tails like that, and baboons don't live here."




Billy stood in shock when he saw the animal. It was a dinosaur like in his books and cartoons!

"Am I being fooled? I must film this! The zoo will want proof!"


Billy looked for his phone.

Billy didn't want to spook it.


"Can I look at your foot?"

"I have just the tools to make the pain go poof!"




Billy took a first aid kit out of his bag. Then, he took out the wood, washed the dinosaur's foot, and looped a bandage over it. All good!
