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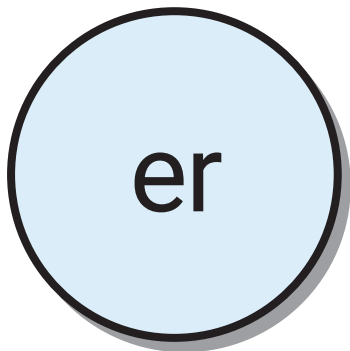

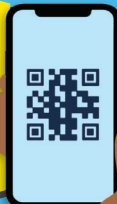

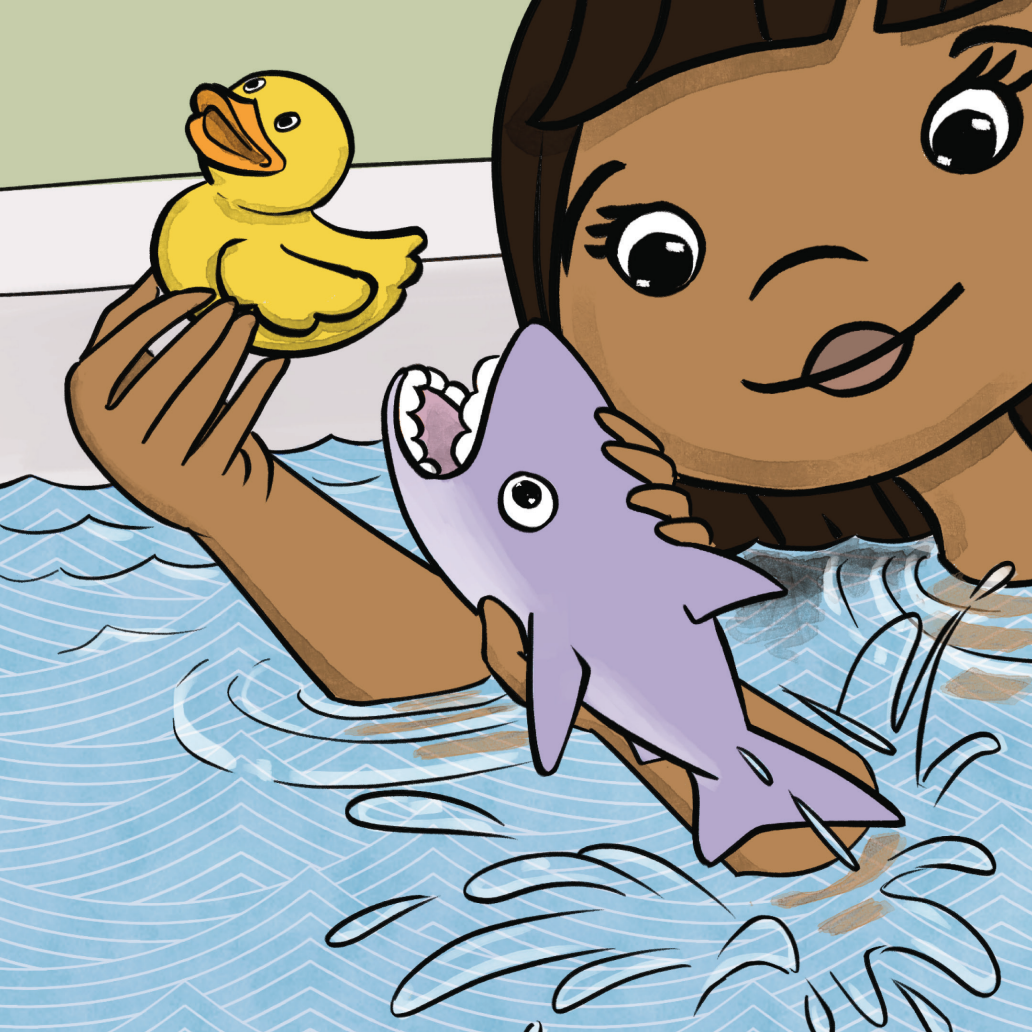

“Look!” says Harper. “It’s a river. Let’s go swimming.”

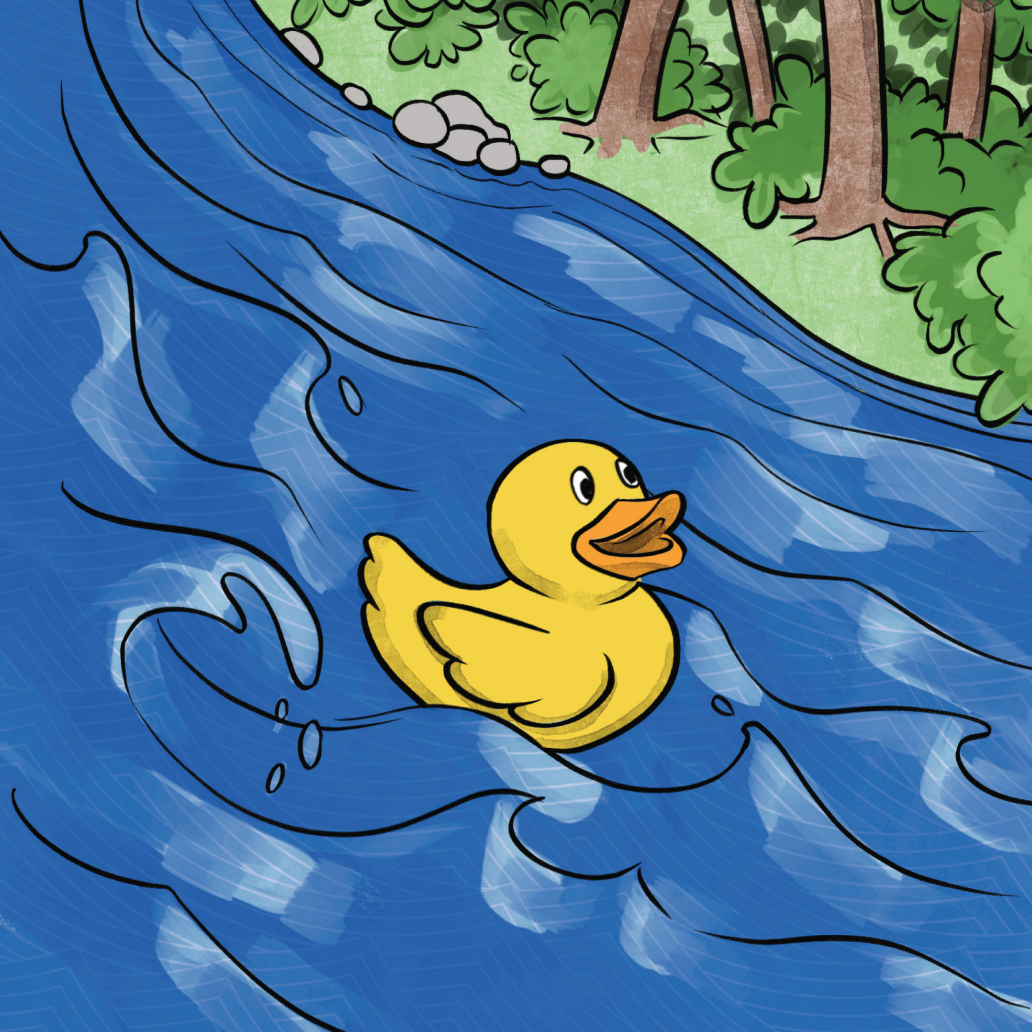


While playing in the water,

shifts closer and closer.



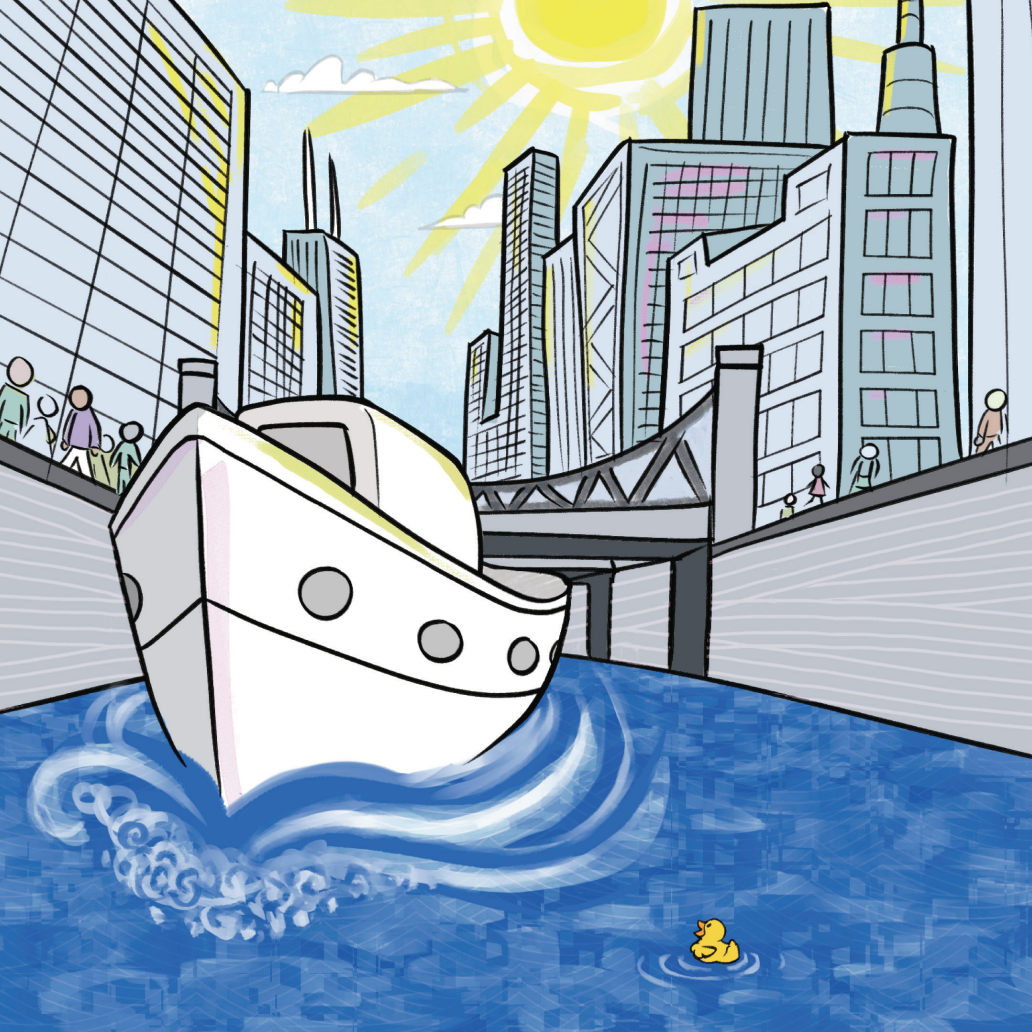
Uh-oh. The water ushers me into the river. It moves me faster as I get farther from Harper. The water twists and jerks me side to side.

I wonder where the river is taking me. It would be better if I was with Harper.



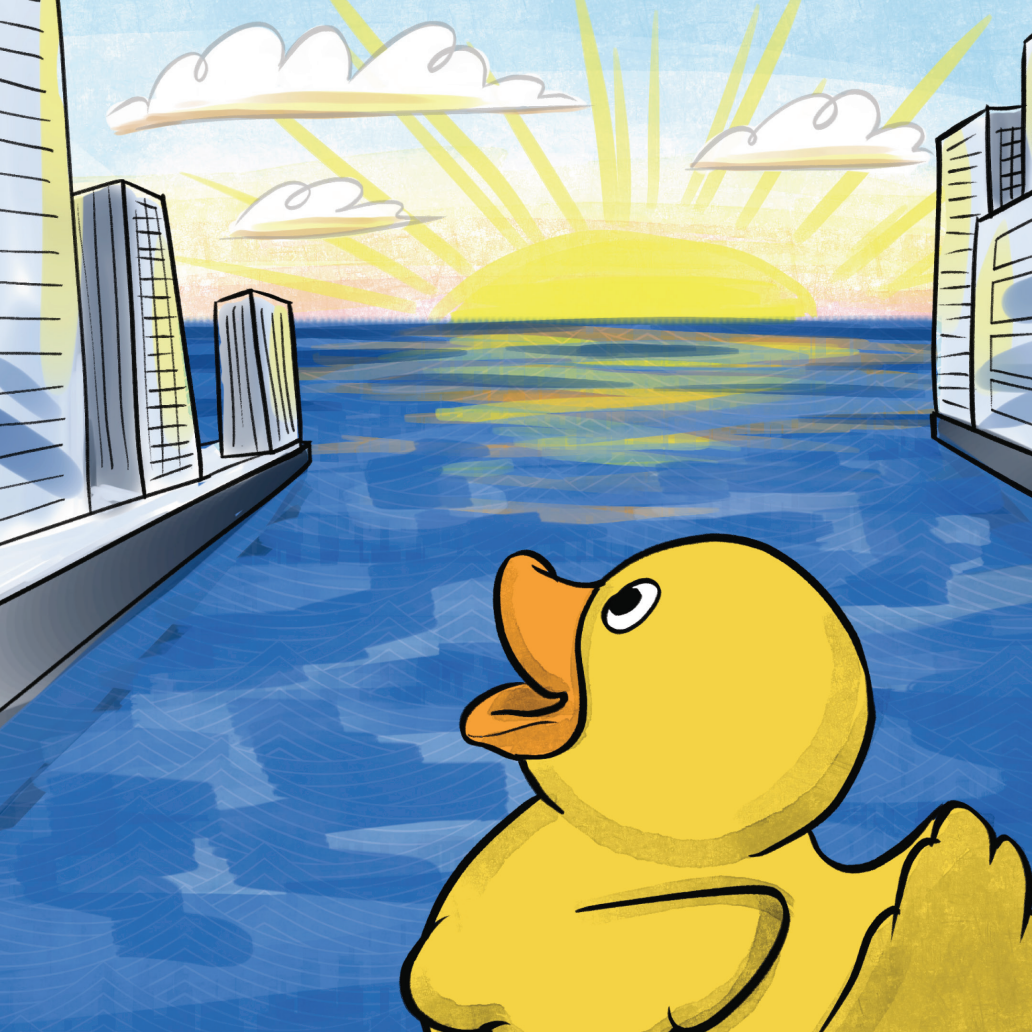
Time passes. The river widens,
