

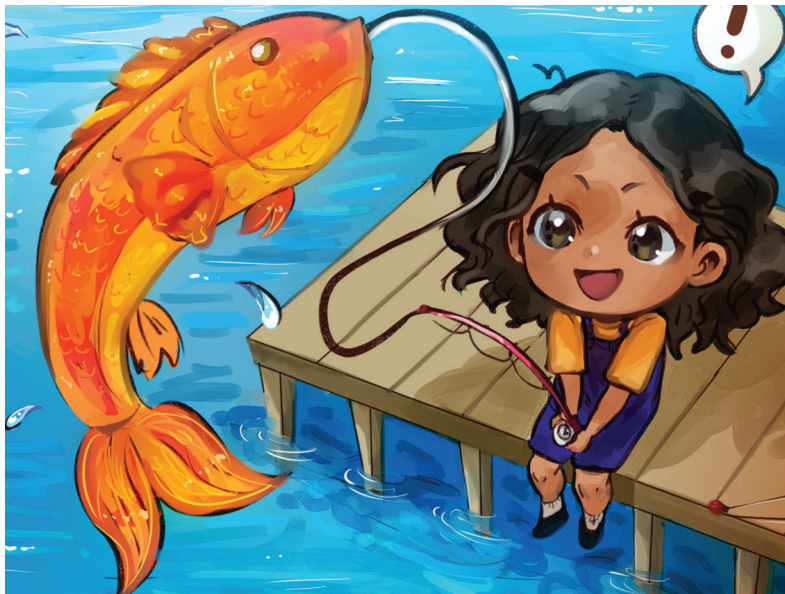

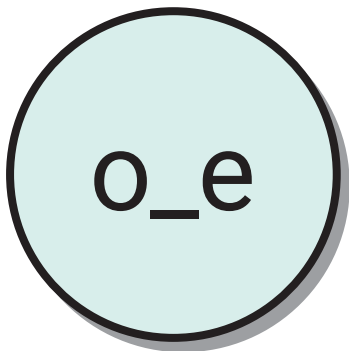

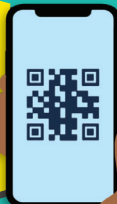

Nicole and Dad tell fish jokes as they walk.

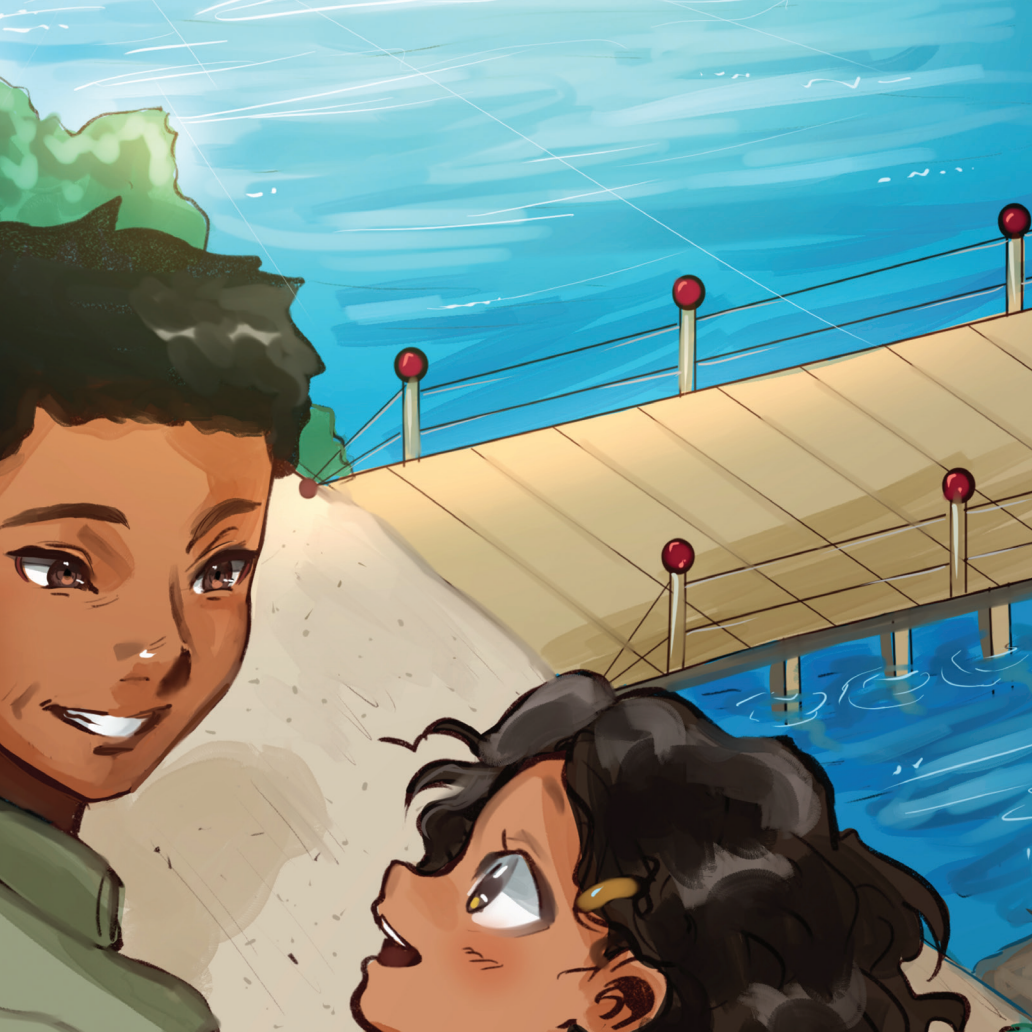
“What is a fish with no eyes?”

Nicole hopes to get a bite on the line.

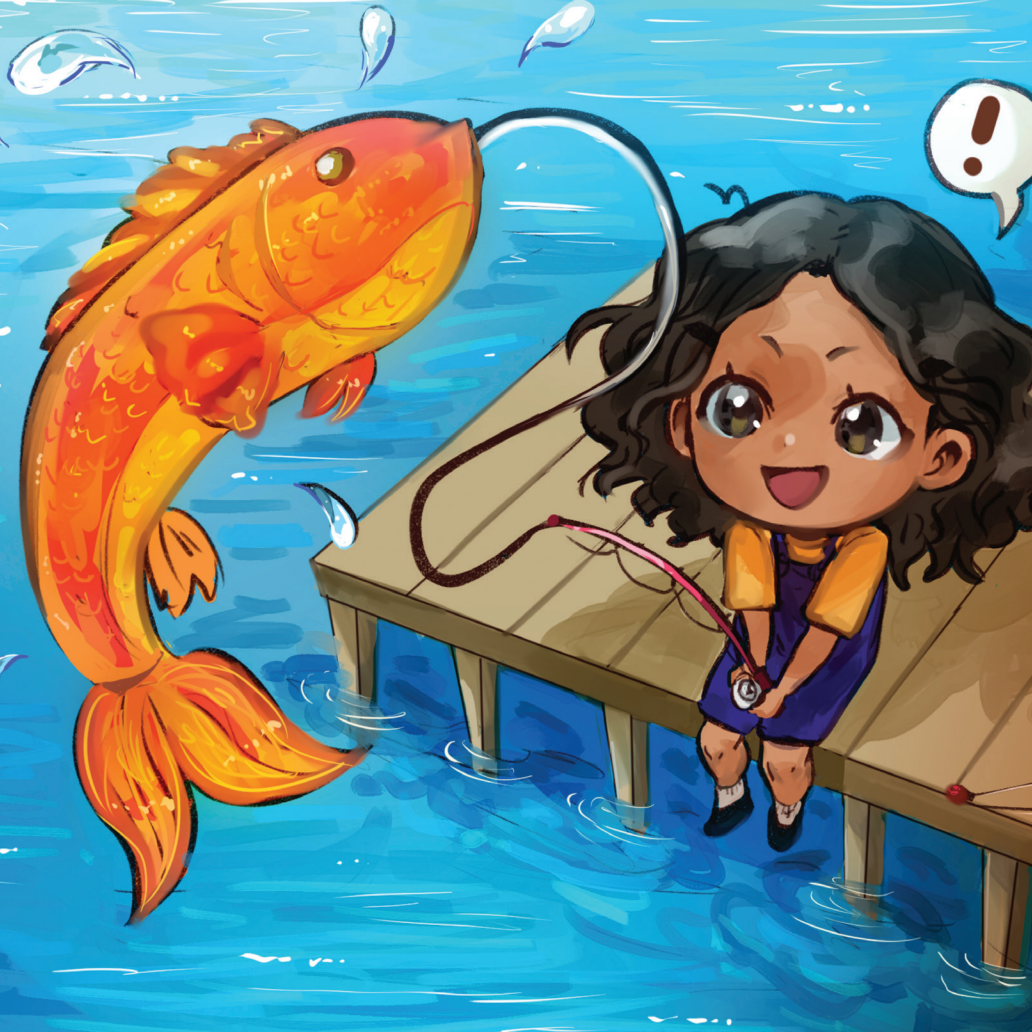


Nicole gets a tug on her pole!
