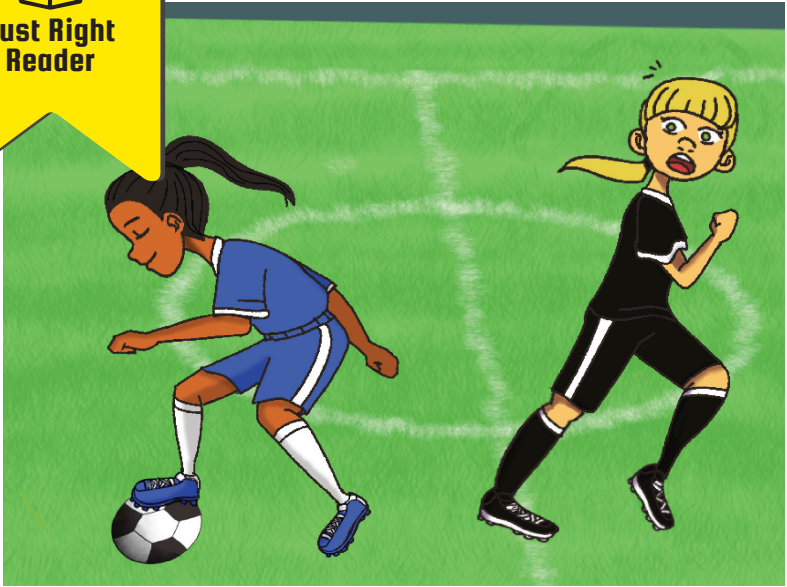


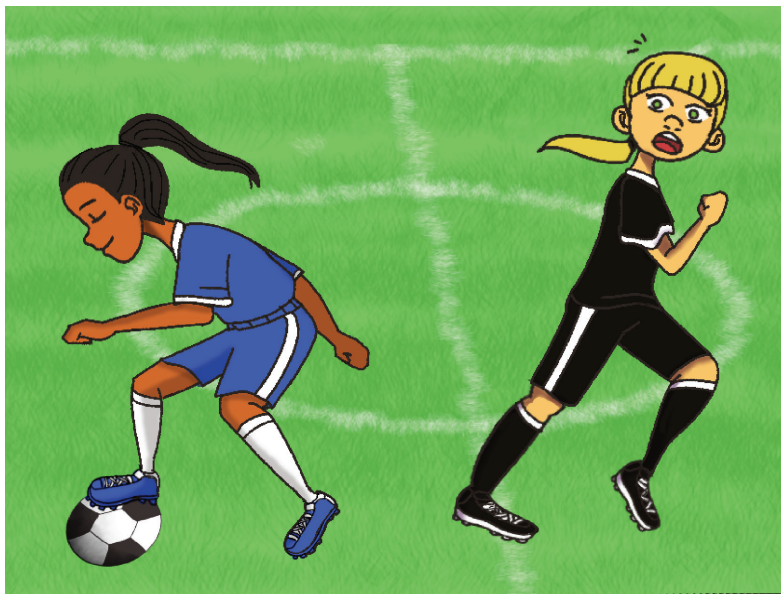

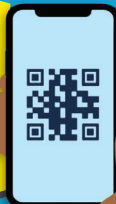

Jean played soccer three times each week with her team. The other days, her mom was her coach and teacher. Together, they worked on new moves.

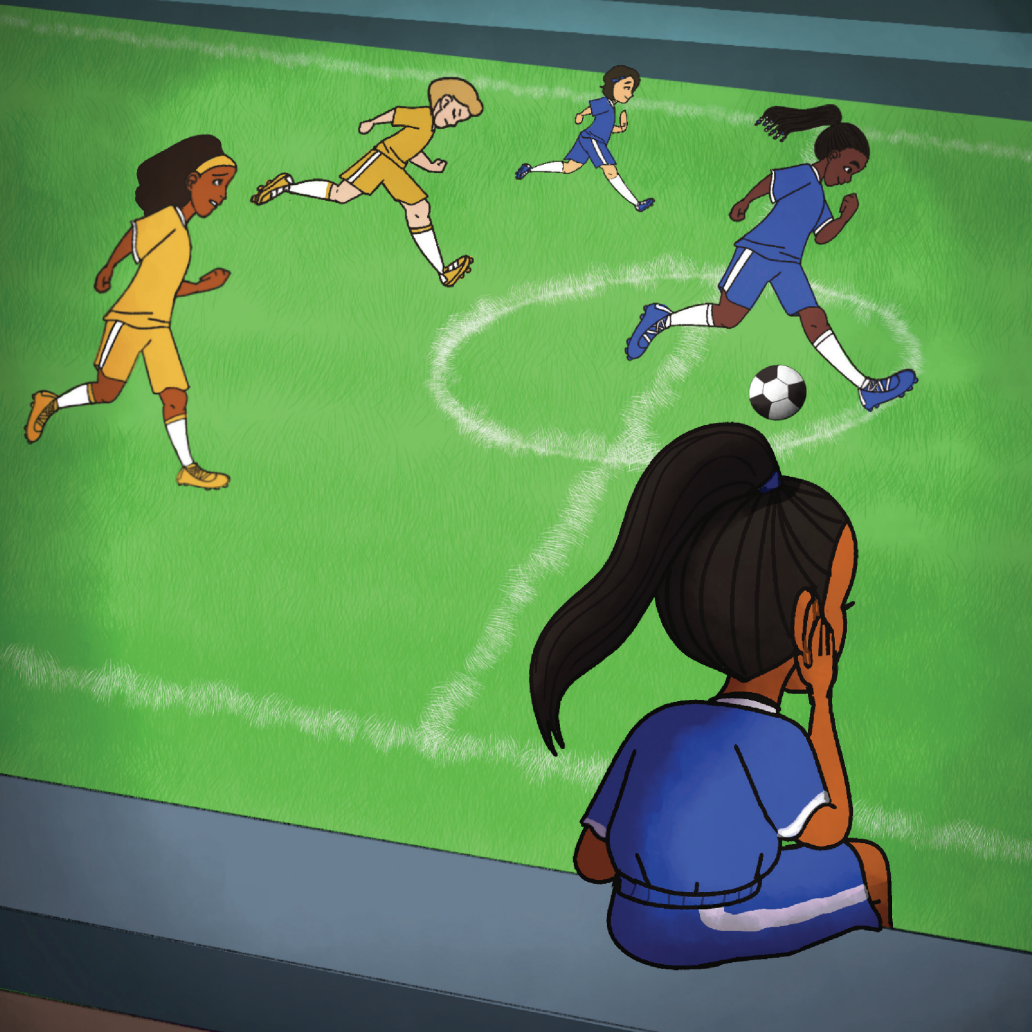
She dreamed of being a starter.
