They all said, "Vote for me!"

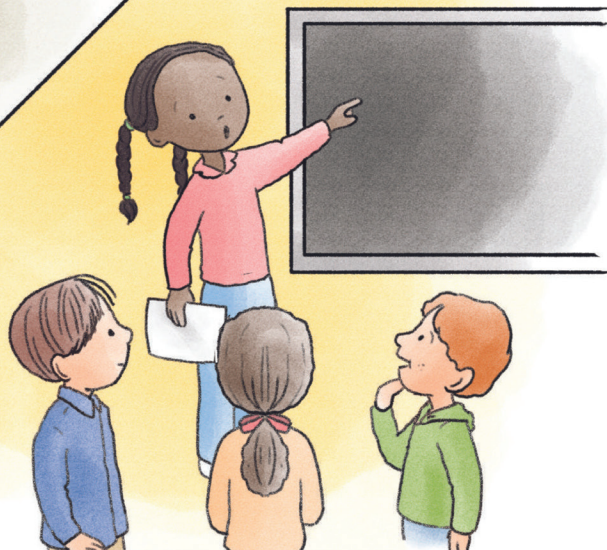

Rachel makes her vote.

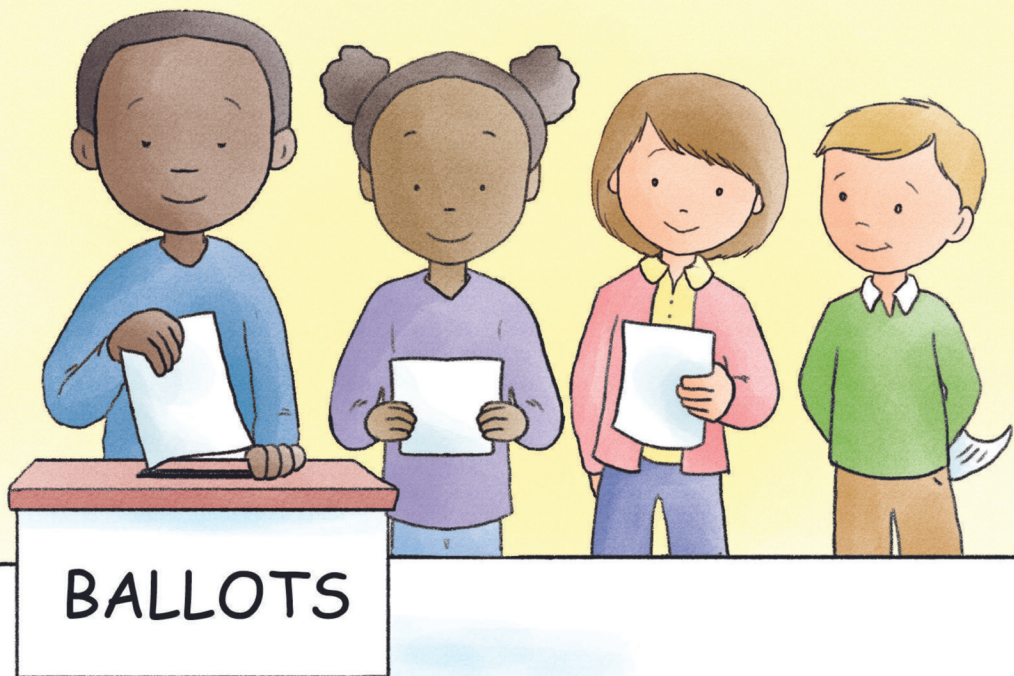


Rachel stands in line with her vote.

She chose her candidate. She hopes they will win.

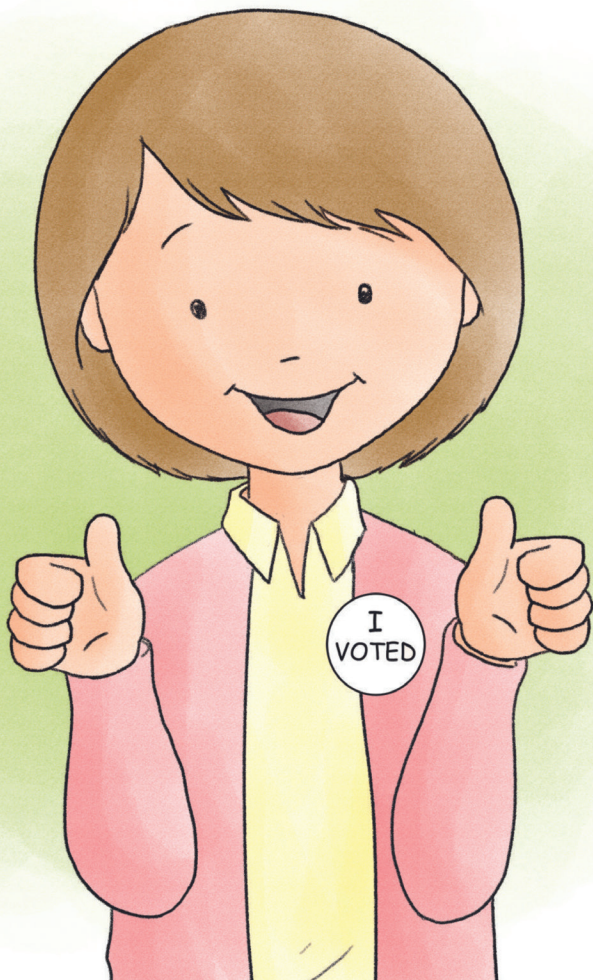
