

It was dark at the farm and Sloth could see the stars. He went to the barn to see his barnyard pals. Sloth went in the barn to see them.








Sloth departed the barn into the dark. He saw a carpet not too far and made it his nap spot. It was not hard like the yarn mat in the barn.




The cart came to a sharp stop in the garden. It gave Sloth quite a start! He could see the farm from the hill in the garden.
