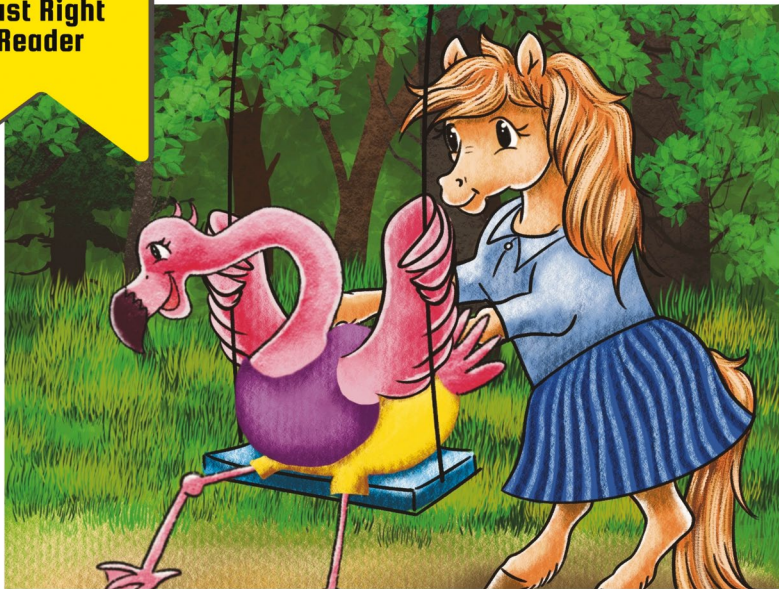


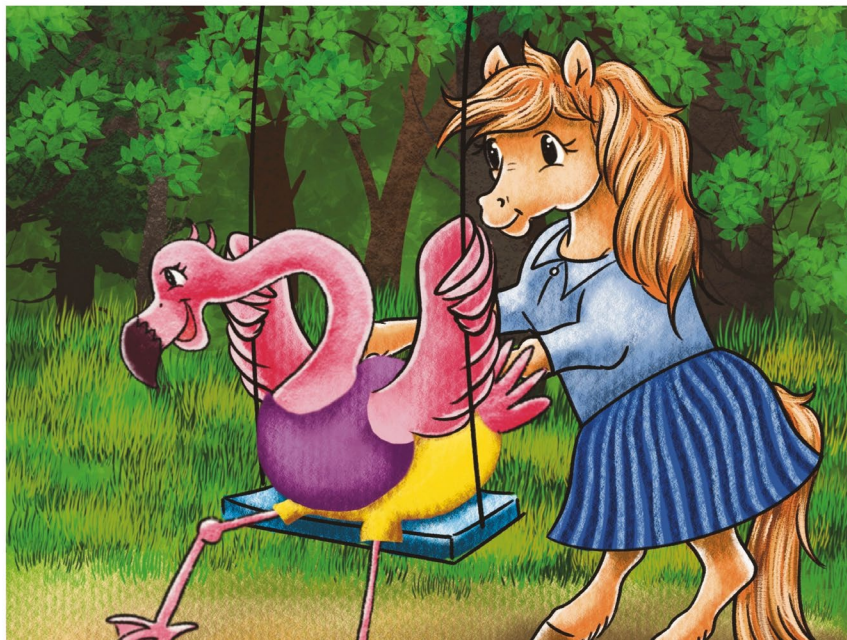

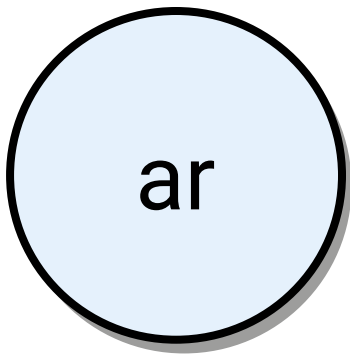

Flamingo thinks the bars are hard. They are too far apart for her. She can't go far.

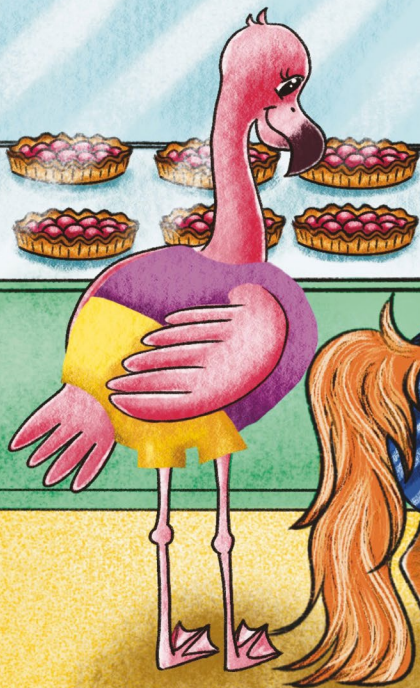
The slide sparks her thinking. Flamingo likes this part! It's not hard to slide.

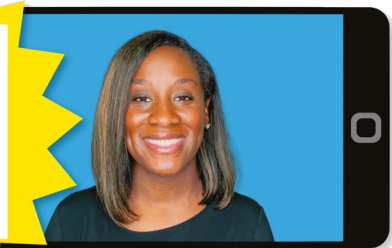
