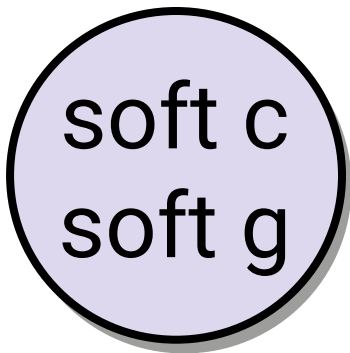

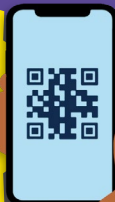

The friends are so intelligent with their genius ideas!



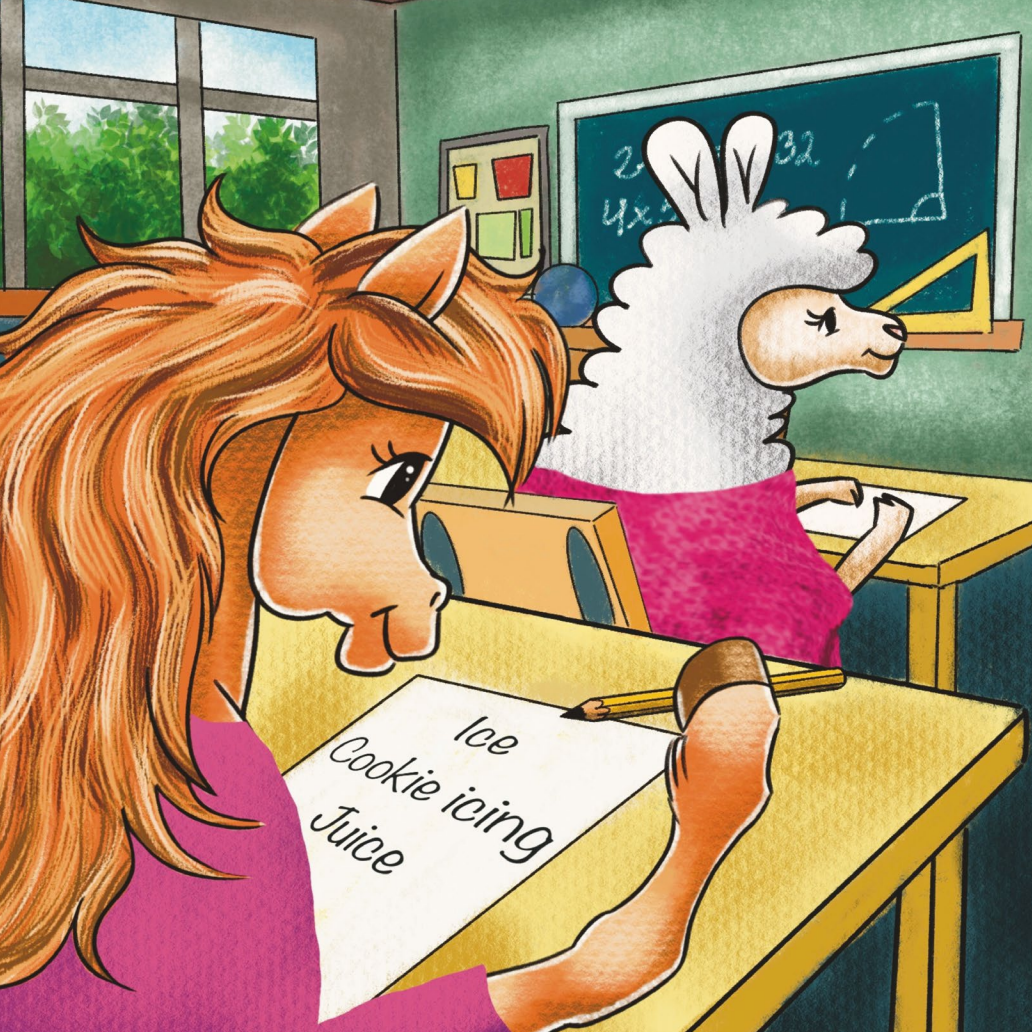

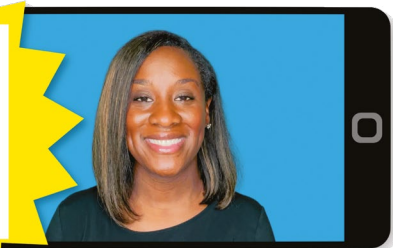
