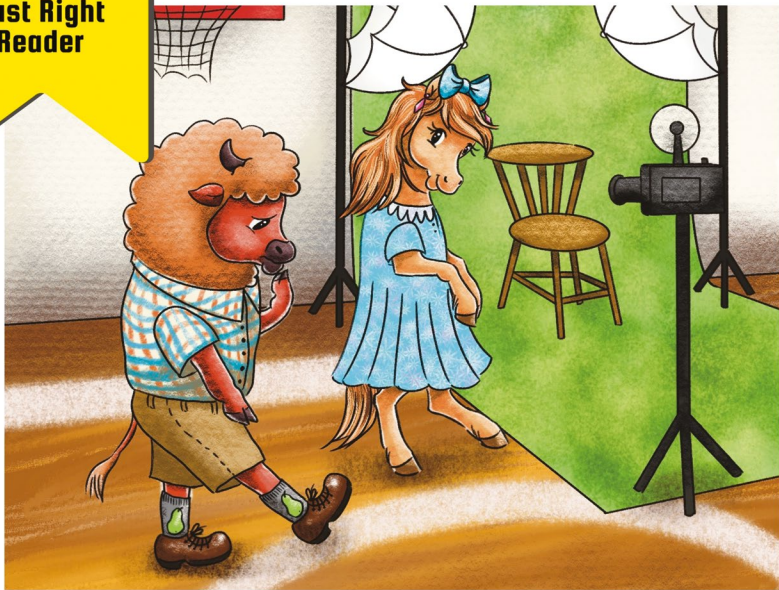




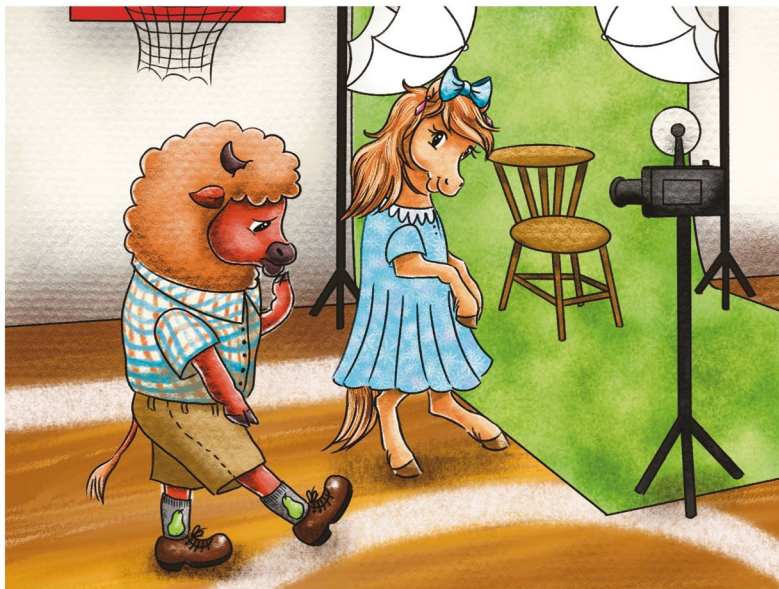

At school, George shares his fear that he didn't wear the right pair of socks.

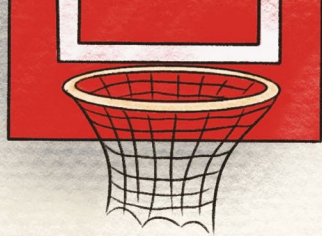
"I love your socks with the pear!" says Kat.

Clearly, Kat has no fear.



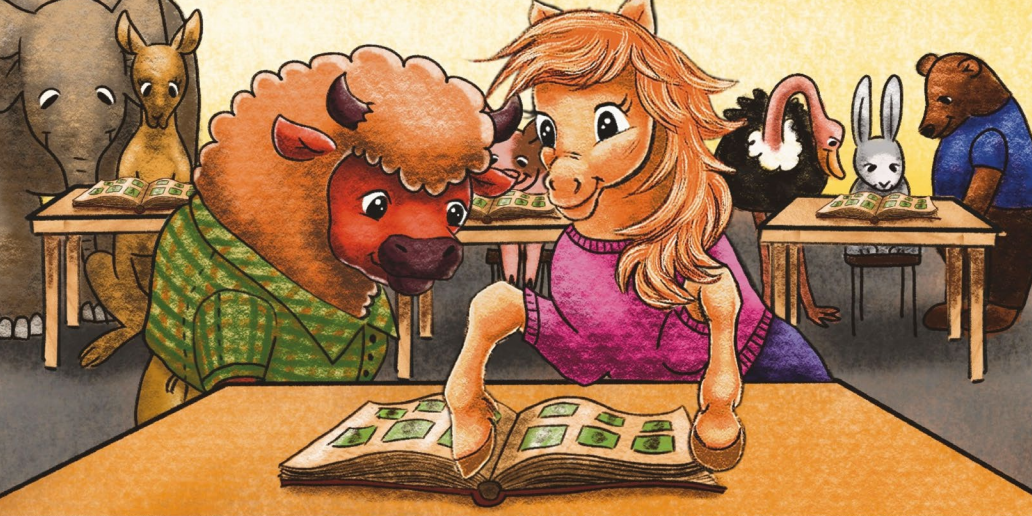


Later, they get to see their photos in the yearbook.

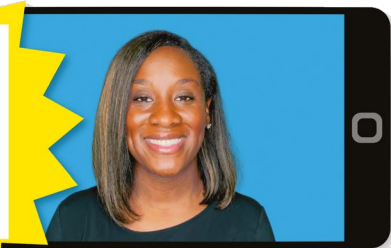
