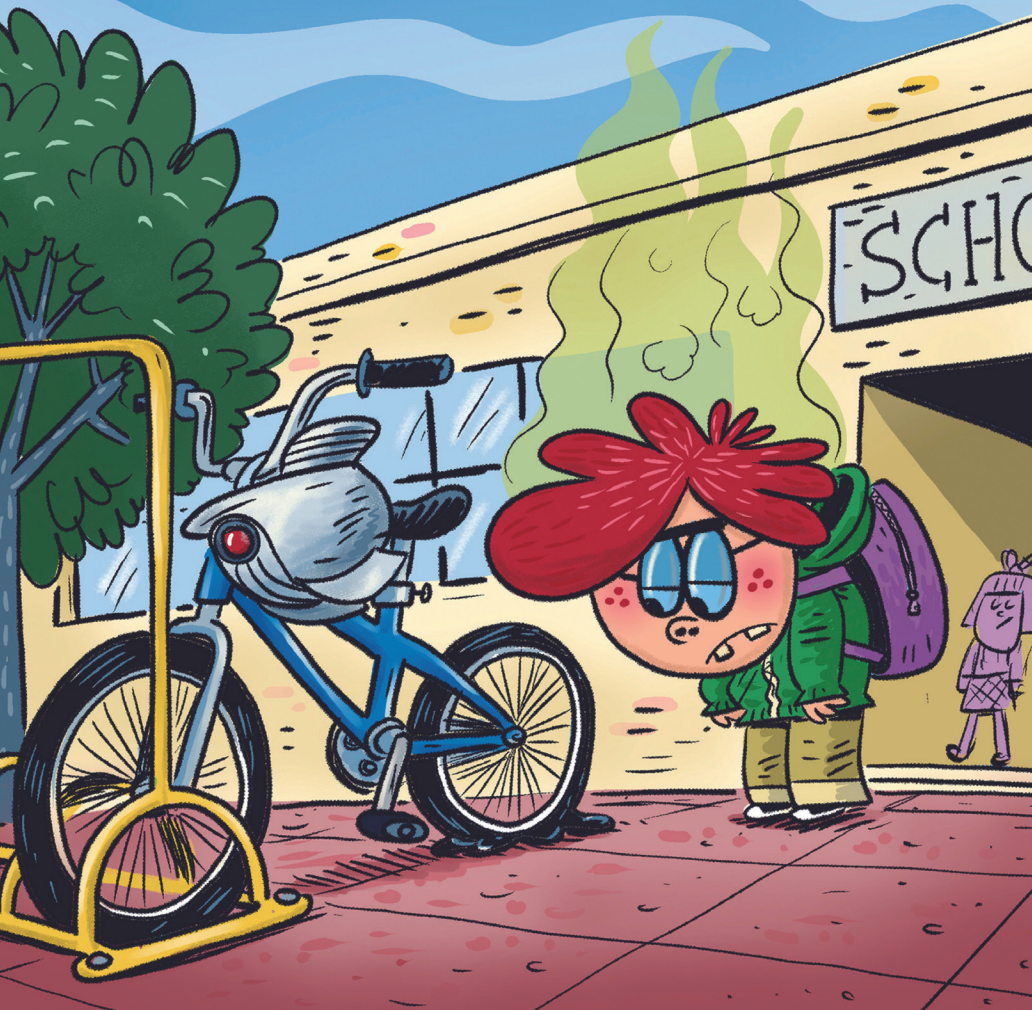




The bell chimes. Mike is shocked!

some advice."



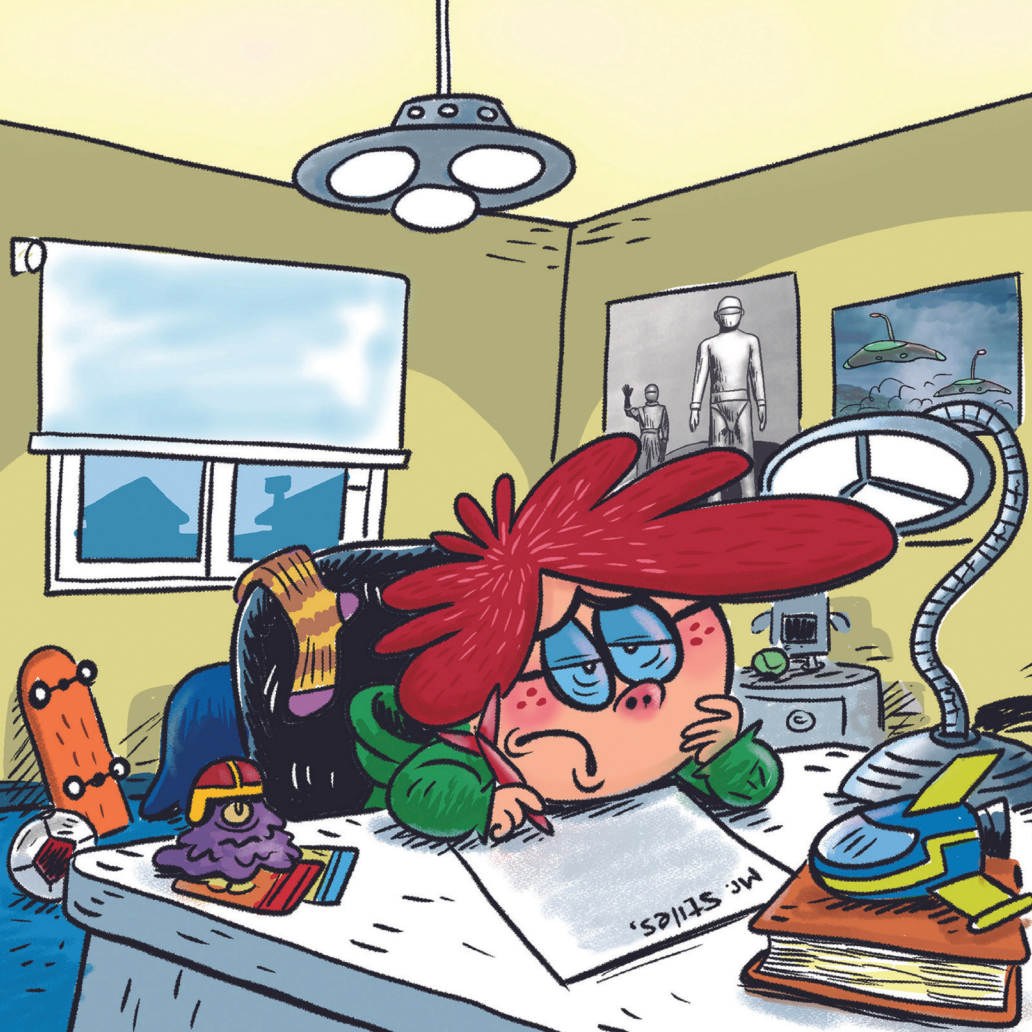


Their chat was nice.
