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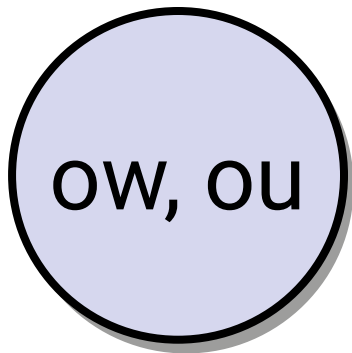

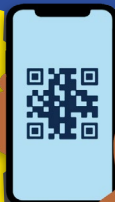
New Vocabulary

They were a rowdy crowd. They had bounced on Matt's trampoline and lost count of the times going round and round, up and down.

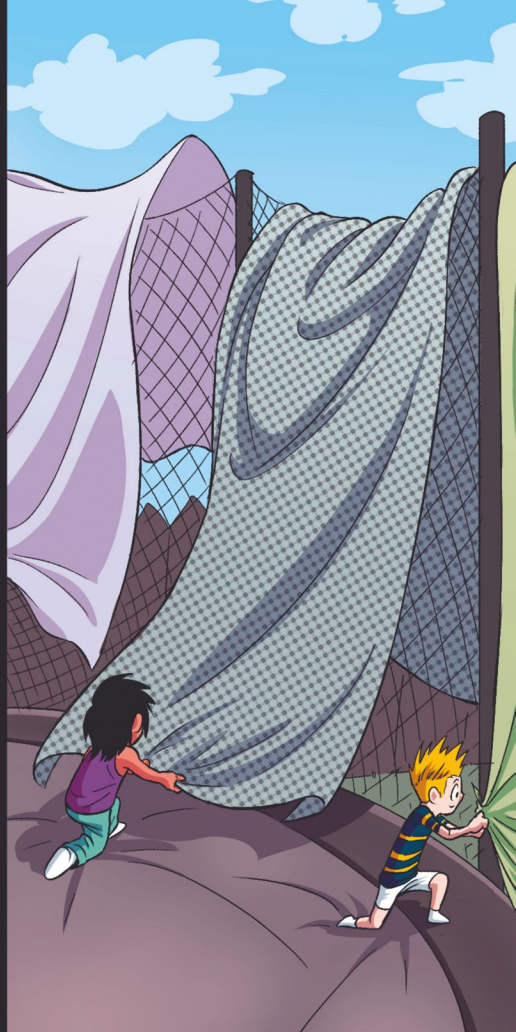
They were proud of their flips.

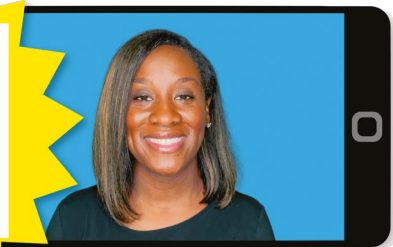
