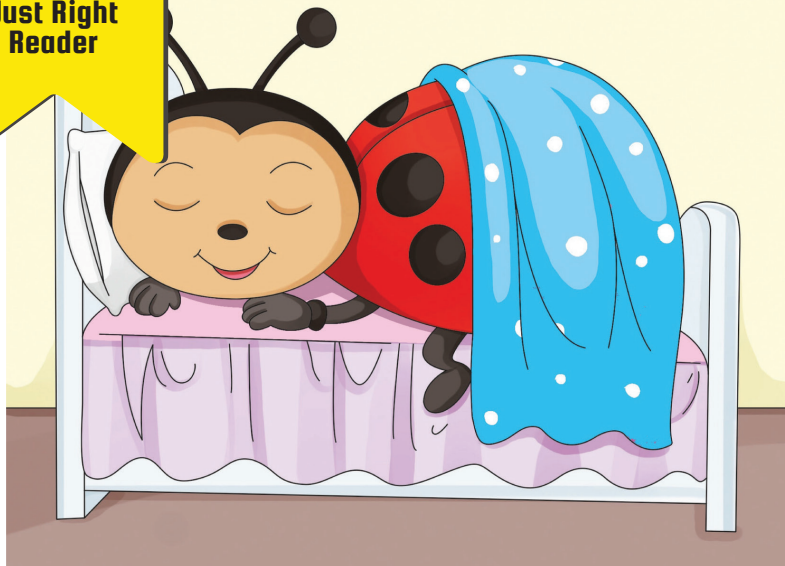

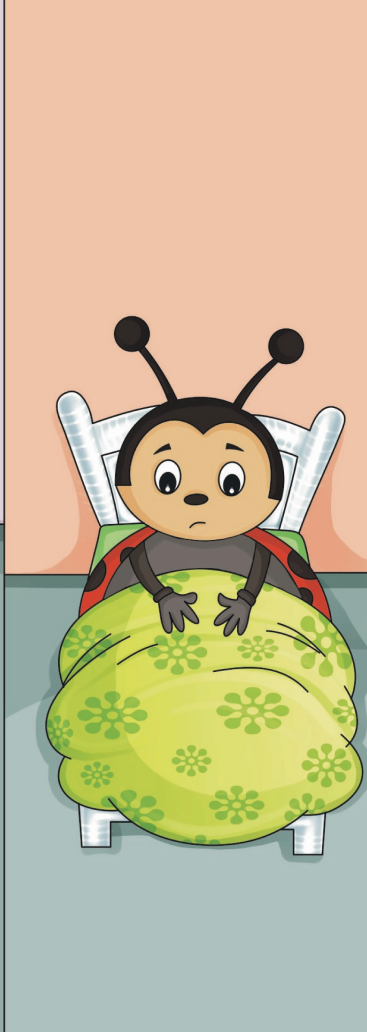


The tan bed is BIG.
